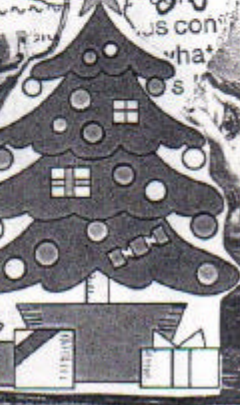
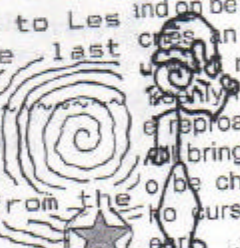

FINSBURY PARK...

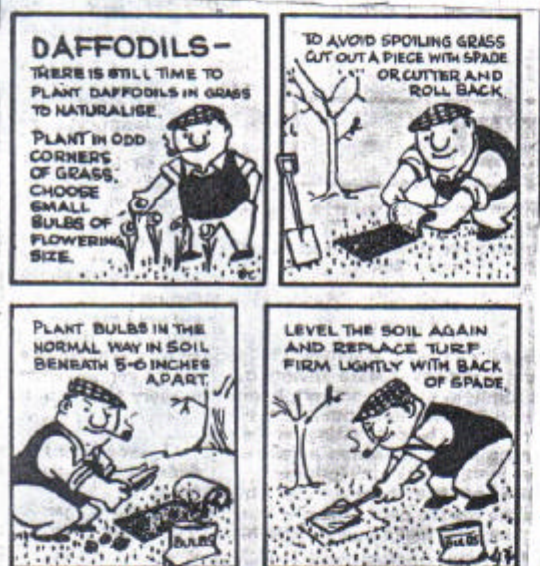

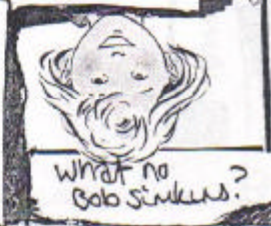


DO YOU PREFERE SMALL GIGS OR LARGE FESTIVALS?

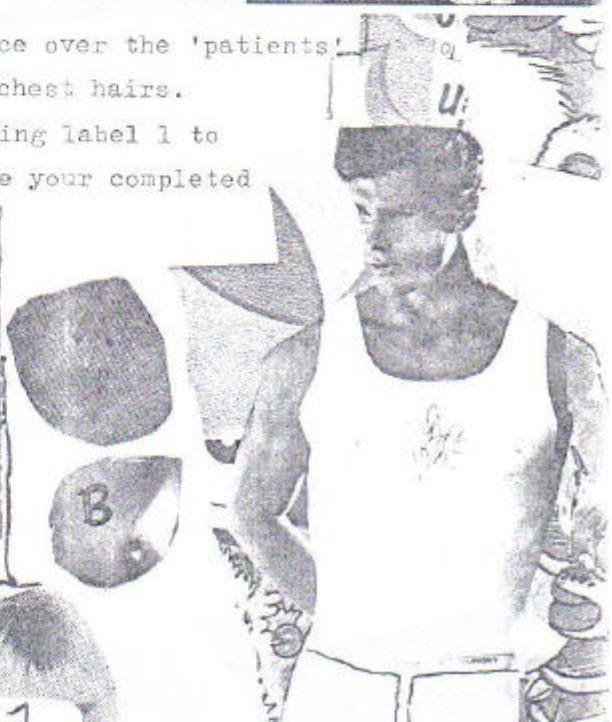

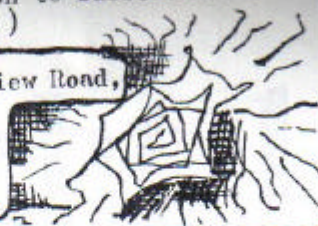
